# **TODOS SANTOS**




# HOTEL SAN CRISTÓBAL

Named in honor of Saint Christopher, patron of travelers, surfers, sailors and protector during long journeys, Hotel San Cristóbal sits on the southwestern edge of the Baja peninsula. Positioned along the Tropic of Cancer and framed by the Sierra de la Laguna mountains, Punta Lobos, and the Pacific Ocean, there is something about the quality of light here. The cycles of the days and seasons, the sunrises, sunsets and tides, and the majesty of the night sky are the hotel's greatest amenities.

Hotel San Cristóbal consists of 32 rooms situated around a central pool and lounge, designed by architects Lake | Flato to complement the beauty of the surrounding terrain. The intimate property is home to three restaurants and beach club as well as a library, a seaside mirador, and a small retail shop. The hotel has several spaces for celebrations and weddings from La Capilla, the hotel's beautiful chapel and event hall, to a secluded yoga platform with a breathtaking view overlooking the mountains and ocean.

# HOTEL SAN CRISTÓBAL PROPERTY BUYOUT

## **BUYOUT POLICIES**

If your event will have more than 30 guests, we require a full buyout of the hotel. For a 3-night minimum stay, there is a food and beverage minimum..

For groups of 35 or fewer guests, we require a minimum booking of 5 rooms. If you are booking over 15 rooms for a group, we require a full buyout of the hotel.

## **COSECHA**

is not included and is open to the public during buyouts. To close Cosecha there is an additional.

#### **SEASONAL RATES**

Rates will fluctuate depending on date and require a 20% occupancy tax and 15% service fee.

**High Season:** November to June **Low Season:** July to October

# **OCEAN VIEW STUDIO**

Located above the hotel restaurant and indoor bar, the Ocean View Studio offers stunning views of the pool and the ocean beyond from the second floor. These spacious rooms have an incredibly comfortable, handmade natural fiber king bed, interior lounge space and a large shared patio overlooking the pool and poolside lounge.

# **OCEAN VIEW KING**

Located on the beach with uninterrupted views of the Pacific and Punta Lobos, the spacious Ocean View King room has a deluxe, natural fiber king bed, writing desk, comfortable seating indoors and out, private patio with sliding screen, and a variety of amenities.









## **OCEAN VIEW DOUBLE QUEEN**


Boasts nearly 500 sq ft of combined indoor and private outdoor lounge space with an uninhibited view of the Pacific Ocean. ## **MOUNTAIN VIEW KING**

On the second floor, overlooking the Sierra de la Laguna mountains. Each features a handmade, natural fiber king bed, a writing desk, and lounge seating both inside and out. Book rooms 54 and 55 together to enjoy the terrace privately, or ask for room 60 for access to a shared rooftop terrace.

# **EVENT POLICIES**

#### **NO CHILDREN POLICY**

During shoulder dates or dates that are not part of the contracted buyout night children under the age of 15 are not allowed at the hotel.

#### DOGS

We welcome dogs at Hotel San Cristobal for an additional cost. Please call us to let us know if you plan to bring your canine companion so we can prepare your room accordingly.

#### **COMMON AREAS**

The hotel keeps regular inventory of items in common areas for guest enjoyment and use. During your group's stay, these items are for use for guest enjoyment while on property. We understand that throughout your group's stay, these items may be used in various locations throughout the grounds. However, upon the conclusion of your agreement, should these items not be found on property and be determined missing or damaged by the Hotel, the replacement cost for these items will be billed to the Master Account.

#### **SECURITY**

The Hotel is not responsible for the safekeeping of the equipment, supplies, written materials, or any other valuable items left in function rooms by the Group. Accordingly, the Group acknowledges that it will be responsible to provide security for any such above mentioned items and hereby assumes responsibility of loss thereof. With advanced notice, your Group Coordinator can assist you in arranging for security officers and indicate if additional charges are applicable.

#### **COMMERCIAL PHOTOGRAPHY**

Commercial photography is prohibited without express permission from the hotel. Please contact us with all commercial photography requests.

### SUBCONTRACTORS/POLICY AGREEMENT

Client that agrees to have any subcontracted companies such as; theme companies, decorators, audio-visual, production companies, etc., applies to these policies. Decorations or displays brought into the hotel by the guest must be approved prior to arrival in order to prevent damages to the furnishing in the hotel. Items may not be attached to any stationary wall, floor, and window with nails or staples, tape or any other substance. Client will assume all responsibility for any damage to hotel premises from such items.

#### **EVENTS MANAGER**

The Hotel Events Manager will assist with all the details on menu planning, set ups, audiovisual, signage, and other aspects of private group functions. All arrangements should be finalized at least THIRTY DAYS (30) prior to your arrival. Due to hotel policy and licenses, all food and beverage must be purchased from the hotel.

#### SHIPPING ITEMS TO THE PROPERTY

Because of the complications of shipping items to a remote location and the government's precise guidelines on imports, we do not recommend shipping items to the property. If your program requires shipment of material to (Hotel San Cristobal Baja) please discuss these details with our Events Manager as soon as possible. The hotel is not responsible for items lost in customs or liable for any importation costs.

#### WATER RELATED SPORTS AND ACTIVITIES
